



## Resurrection Parish Cornerstone Experience

The Resurrection Parish Cornerstone Experience is about parishioners like you getting together and sharing some of life's issues while trying to live your faith amidst the sometimes overwhelming challenges of life, and looking at them through a different lens. Perhaps you are feeling that...

- You are under pressures trying to blend the responsibilities of family, faith, and work.
- Maybe, because of your values, you're feeling detached from today's society.
- You've been "away," and you'd like to reconnect with your faith.
- You have children or grandchildren preparing for the Sacraments, and you'd like to be more involved but don't know where to begin.

The voluntary 26-hour Experience begins on a Friday at 6:30pm, with a gathering meal, and ends on Saturday after the 5:00pm Mass. During the Experience, members of the Cornerstone Team deliver thematic faith-based talks, and you'll have an chance to discuss these topics. The atmosphere is relaxed and casual, and you may share in a discussion, or not at all. There will be opportunities to examine your relationship with God, your family and others in your life. The atmosphere provides a chance to reflect, refocus and renew your faith.

There will be opportunities for self-reflection, Mass, Reconciliation, and the Eucharist. Small and large group activities, very good food, and fellowship are all part of the experience.

**At Cornerstone** you will have an occasion to develop a relationship with other parishioners in a confidential, warm, welcoming, and non-judgmental environment. Most of all, it is a chance to step out of your daily routine. You'll have time to think about those issues which matter most to you. While there is a focus on activities and discussions, the fact that we spend quality time together, experiencing God, and building a stronger parish community is what Cornerstone is about.
