

"ART GLASS" INSTALLATIONS

The remaining four parish "art glass" works have now been installed around the Narthex area for all to see.

"CHRIST, THE KING" is hanging over the Ministry counter. (This was completely restored.)

"CHRIST ON THE WAY TO CALVARY" is over the window on the stairwell side of the Main Entrance Doors.

"SMALL CROSS" is over the window outside Room 7 in the second floor hallway.

"SYMBOLS OF CHRIST / EUCHARIST" is hanging on the interior window between the Narthex and the Ambulatory. The "fish" as an early church anagram/acromyn comes from the Greek: IKHTHUS: "Jesus Christ Son of God Savior" (Iesous Christos theos hyios soter). It is overlaid with the "markings" of a baked loaf of bread and placed over the CHI RHO, one of the earliest forms of christograms, formed by superimposing the first 2 letters (CHI and RHO) of the Greek: XPISTOS = Christos = Christ.

The Parish is very grateful to the parishioners who funded this restoration and installation of our "art glass" works.
